Inca's Field - Terms and Conditions

Sessions:

Each session lasts for 1 hour with a 10-minute gap between the end and the start of each session; to allow you time to leave the field before another member arrives. Please make sure you leave the field promptly at the end of your session and leave the car park as soon as possible. In each session, there is to be a total maximum of 6 dogs. If you are a dog walking business or run dog classes and would like to use the field, please contact us to discuss your requirements. There are 4 allocated parking spaces available for the field, but space for a few more vehicles.

On Arrival & Leaving Inca's Field:

Please do not enter the field until the previous member has left it. Please make sure the gate is secured using the slide bolts on the inside, after entering. The lower one is optional and is to stop anyone else entering the field whilst you are in there. Always secure the gate shut when your session has ended. If you arrive in the car park before the previous member has left, please wait in your vehicle until they have left the field, and their dog(s) are in the vehicle. You must leave the car park before the next booking starts. Vehicles and their contents are to be left at the owner's risk. Please note that dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control until they are securely in the field and when leaving.

Inca's Field:

Despite our field having a 2-metre-high deer fence, it is a rural field with foxes, deer, rabbits, badgers, etc. roaming; all of which can damage fences or dig. We are unable to guarantee complete security. Your use of the field is, therefore, entirely at your own risk. We regularly check the field for any potential hazards but will not be held responsible if something has been accidently missed. If there are any livestock in any neighbouring fields, please do not allow or encourage your dog(s) to interact with them. Please pick up all dog mess and take it home with you. No picnics, BBQs, grooming of dogs or cigarette smoking are allowed and all games and similar, are to be with dogs only.

AGILITY EQUIPMENT IS STRICTLY FOR DOGS ONLY!

This is to prolong the life of the equipment and for your safety. Please take all litter home with you (no toys should be left behind). To keep the field as safe as possible, please discourage your dog from digging and please kindly leave the field in the state you would wish to find it. Fresh water is available.

XL Bully Dogs:

For XL Bully dog owners regarding the use of our secure dog field, by dogs defined as an XL Bully and the change of law as of 31st December 2023. You must follow the requirements as set out below:

- Your dog must be on a lead and muzzled until you have entered Inca's Field, and the gate has been securely locked with **BOTH** slide bolts.
- You can remove the lead and muzzle once inside Inca's Field.
- Your dog must be put back on a lead and muzzled before opening the gate to leave the field.

- The dog handler ratio is 1:1 with their handler at all times.
- If your household has more than 1 dog, they can come to the field together as long as they have a minimum of 1 handler. All dogs leads and muzzles can be removed once in the field, including the XL Bully.
- If there are dogs from different households, the banned breed will need to remain muzzled and on a lead at all times with a 1:1 handler.
- Your dog must be registered with the index of exempted dog (IED)
- Your dog is Micro Chipped.
- Your dog is neutered in line with Government Rules

Health:

We ask that your dog is microchipped, immunised, and wormed. Please do not bring your dog(s) if they are unwell, unless recovering from an operation.

Cancellation:

We (the owners) reserve the right to close the field, cancel or refuse a booking at any time. Please allow 24 hours' notice to cancel by email (incasfield@hotmail.com) otherwise payment for your order will still be due.

Final Note:

If any of the above terms are breached, then we reserve the right to stop any persons/dogs from using Inca's Field and your membership ended.
